The Topic: Kevin Kavanagh and Nick Yarmoshuk will present what has become an annual discussion, with a slideshow, of the strengths, weaknesses and usefulness of each variety of rhododendron and azalea available at the Annual Plant Sale. Always a freewheeling session, participants share experiences & techniques in growing these plants, hear about new research and profit from Kevin's detailed knowledge of growing rhododendrons across a wide area of Ontario and from Nick's experiences in St. Catharines and his rhododendron research odysseys.



Kevin Kavanagh: Those who have met Kevin will know of his passion for plants and appreciation of nature instilled in him when he was growing up surrounded by forests and wetlands in Quebec's Eastern Townships. His interests in plants of southern regions set in at an early age as he struggled to find ways to overwinter broad leaved Rhododendrons in his parents' backyard where temperatures regularly dipped to -30 F. Today he and his partner reside on 28 acres overlooking wetland bordering Lake Erie. Kevin held full-time positions at World-Wildlife Fund Canada, and the Nature Conservancy of Canada before opening South Coast Gardens in the midst of the rich Carolinian forests of Norfolk County. Kevin holds a B.Sc. (Hons.) from McGill University and an M.Sc. from York University, and undertook several years of post-graduate research in botany, biogeography and plant ecology at the

University of Toronto.



Nick Yarmoshuk: Nick has grown rhododendrons and azaleas in St. Catharines since 1975. He claims this genus is easier to grow more reliably than perennials. Perhaps growing more evergreen azaleas and lepidotes than broadleaf rhododendrons accounts for this relative success. Nick is a founding member of the Niagara Region Chapter and has served as Chapter President, President of the Rhododendron Society of Canada, District Director to the ARS Board of Directors and currently is Secretary to the Niagara Region Board of Directors and Chair of the ARS Test & Display Garden Committee.
